Community Living

Whether you are a short-term or life-long resident, you should introduce yourself to your neighbours. Knowing fellow community members helps to maintain good day-to-day relations.

Be involved in your neighbourhood!

Observe the general standards of appearance in your neighbourhood. Try to make an extra effort to keep trash, old furniture, and other waste items properly stored and sorted.

When planning a social gathering, remember that you are responsible for the safety of your guests and are liable for any damage to a dwelling and to neighbours' property. Also be sensitive to your neighbours' noise tolerances.

Assist new neighbours in understanding and complying with municipal by-laws such as parking, noise, waste, recycling and snow removal.

The Town of Wolfville, Acadia University, the Acadia Students' Union, and interested local residents, property and business owners are committed to working with permanent and short-term residents to ensure that our community continues to be a great place to live, work, study and play.

Community Action Team

Purpose

The purpose of the Community Action Team (CAT) is to help create a sense of community among the members of the Town of Wolfville. The CAT therefore includes a representative from the permanent residents and landlords, students, the university, and the RCMP. The CAT will accomplish this sense of community by providing a mediation and reconciliation service in an effort to create positive long-term relationships.

Collaboration

Reconciliation and positive relationships can only be achieved when each group is part of the solution. This means the CAT includes the input and objectives of all parties with a focus on open discussion, collaboration, and restoration rather than conflict and punishment.

If you have a challenge or conflict with a neighbouring community member, contact any CAT member to facilitate a collaborative resolution.
