



Strategies for Multiple Choice Exams

Read the question carefully

Underline key words. Pay attention to words such as “always” or never”. Translate the question using your own words—what is being asked? Read all the options, even if the first option seems correct

Cross out options

Are there options you know are wrong? Cross them off to narrow your choices

Think of the right answer

Try and think of the correct answer before you read the options

Stuck on a question?

Try and answer the question. Put a star next to the question and re-visit it later, if you have time
